Improvement Process (CSIP)

**Continuous School Improvement Findings**

School teams create a 1-2 page report (shared with the BOE) that displays their **Data and Findings, Key Learnings/Celebrations, and Considerations for Development of Upcoming CSIP Plan.**

An Unconference (participant driven learning experience), speaker, or other type of professional learning leadership opportunity concludes the CSIP cycle.

**Driven By Data Retreat**  
(formally Data Dig)

The purpose of this day is for your CSIP leadership team [approx. 5-8 educators plus administrator(s)] to attend different sessions that will strengthen the use of data within the CSIP process. Each of the data sessions will provide a deeper dive into different aspects of your current data. This deeper dive is intended to help you be more intentional in the school goal you set as well as more deliberate in planning the high impact actions that will help your site meet that goal. We are hoping the data institute sessions will help you make more informed decisions that assist you as you monitor your progress.

**Clarifying Retreat**

Site Leadership Teams craft improvement goals, as well as begin to identify objectives and strategies (action plans) to support the achievement of the goal.

Teams may choose to work through differentiated WI RtI Center modules for establishing and/or strengthening their selected and intensive levels of support for mathematics or reading. This will result in a specific RtI objective and actions within the Continuous School Improvement Plan.

**Reflection Retreat**

Site Leadership Teams reconvene to reflect and respond to data collected during the improvement cycles, as well as the improvement process.

Teams complete the online School-Wide Implementation Review (SIR) self-assessment to monitor annual progress toward full RtI implementation.

**Site Team Meetings**

Minimally, Site Leadership Teams meet monthly at their sites to implement, adjust, and monitor CSIP.

Monthly progress monitoring data informs progress toward CSIP goal(s).

**Commitment Retreat**

*Site Leadership Teams establish progress monitoring and evaluation activities, as well as roll-out plans critical to the improvement planning cycle.*
