

Career Based Learning PK – 12 Benchmarks

PK4 –
Grade 4

- Students will be exposed to various career opportunities to connect to personal interests, talents and employability skills.

Grade
5 - 6

- Students will develop an Academic and Career Plan that represents a match of student interests and academic outcomes.

Grade
7 - 8

- Students will self-reflect and leverage personal and career networks to plan for high school course selections, co-curricular participation, and employment opportunities) to carry out their ACP.

Grade
9 – 10

- Student identifies an adult mentor/advisor from their ACP personal network to articulate their personalized mid-point ACP progress.

Grade
11 – 12

- Students will graduate with a post-secondary plan to implement with a back-up plan, an actual real-world exposure in their career focused area, and participate in a reflective evaluation-exit interview prior to graduation to support their ACP.
